2. Choose your theme wisely


The right WordPress theme will make your site look great

3. Add a caching plugin


Caching is a temporary storage space or memory that allows fast access to data.

SSL prevents hackers from stealing your data. Having SSL will help you gain your audience's trust.






6. Be SEO-friendly






7. Be mobile-friendly
